

### ***Are there fees for staying in the room?***

- Yes, there are room and board fees associated with the residential center.
- Fees are based upon a patient's ability to pay.

### ***When can my family and friends visit?***

- Visitation is allowed at anytime.
- Children and pets are allowed to visit.
- Residents may also choose to leave the facility to spend time with family members.

## Residential Center

The Blue Ridge Hospice Residential Center is the first hospice residential center in northwestern Virginia and the surrounding area. Located at 333 West Cork Street in Winchester, the eight bed residential center provides a serene, home-like environment for hospice patients who do not have a caregiver, or whose family is not able to care for them at home.

The residential center includes private rooms each uniquely decorated by local designers, a large kitchen with a dining area where residents or family members may cook special meals and dine together, and a spacious family room/library.

### ***Who is eligible for the Blue Ridge Hospice Residential Center?***

- Any Blue Ridge Hospice patient
- Patients from other hospice programs who are in need of residential services
- Patients who meet hospice admission criteria and have been referred by their family physician
- A patient who lives alone and is no longer able to care for him or herself

- A patient who has a caregiver that is physically unable to provide care at home
- A patient who does not have adequate family support

*A wait list is maintained for admission.*

### ***What services are offered at the Blue Ridge Hospice Residential Center?***

- Home-style meals and snacks (Family members may bring in special food if desired.)
- Laundry/linen service
- 24 Hour staffing by licensed healthcare professionals
- Planned activities which may include bingo, movie night, music, and Sunday socials
- Continued support and oversight from the homecare interdisciplinary team of nurses, social workers, physicians, certified nursing assistants, music therapists, chaplains, and bereavement counselors

### ***Who are the Center staff?***

The residential center is staffed around the clock by nurses and certified nursing assistants.
